Accompany Doula Care

"I'm worried about not having my partner or my doula with me during my labor " - parent

- Using FaceTime with the doula during labor for virtual support
- Moms at risk of delivering alone could have a doula with them

"I'm worried I will be separated from my baby after birth" - parent

- Doulas providing education prenatally about changing practices at hospitals
- Helping birthing parents understand their options during COVID-19
- Helping birthing parents
 develop a birth plan in light
 of those changes

"I'm worried I won't have my support network around me when we come home" - parent

- Doulas providing education about postpartum community resources
- Doulas provide an additional "check in" with parents after they come home
- Alerting providers when a parent is particularly struggling or shows signs of depression

"How can I work with my patient's doula to help support my patient?" – provider

- Asking the patient if they plan to have a doula with them and if they are willing to share contact information
- Keeping communication about emerging policies flowing to doulas, so we can educate clients prenatally
- Working with doulas to address language barriers while in the hospital

Ways We have Supported our Doulas

- Guides to conduct visits prenatally, including how to connect virtually and what to cover during virtual visits
- Best practices for traveling to/from the hospital so as to not put family members or self at risk
- Communicating emerging policies at various birthing hospitals so doulas/clients can be prepared
- Helping doulas who are not as comfortable or used to virtual technology by providing tip sheets, mentoring, and Q&A during monthly meetings
- Emotionally supporting doulas so they can best serve their clients

When integrated into the healthcare team, Doulas can help communicate the needs of the family and providers during a time of intense change and uncertainty.
